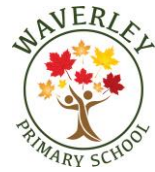

Important Information

Can we please remind you that if your child is late for school, they must be signed in by an adult on our Inventory system at the office. Should you need to collect your child from the office for whatever reason, they must be signed out again via the Inventory system.
